

Committee Descriptions

Banquet--The banquet is held at the end of the football season. Responsibilities include: securing the cafeteria and auditorium, ordering food, mailing invitations, taking reservations, decorating the event, printing the program, handling AV equipment, set-up and clean-up.

Car Wash-- Responsibilities include: Securing a date with sponsor location, printing tickets, distribution of tickets to players, collecting money from players, creating a schedule for players to work, and recruiting parent volunteers to help the day of the event.

Castle Football Website-- Managing and updating www.castlefootball.com.

Community Service-- Coordinating activities for the coaches and players to participate in that gives back to the community.

Corporate Sponsorship-- Develop a corporate sponsorship program to generate funds for the Castle Football program. Secure sponsorship from local businesses. Process all sponsorship requests.

Facebook Page-- Create and manage a facebook page with current Castle Football information.

Father/Son Breakfast-- This event is held at St. John's Church and handled by the boy scouts. Responsibilities of the committee include: securing a date, accept reservations, secure a speaker, set-up and clean-up.

Feeds-- Feeds included the following responsibilities: calling local businesses for food donations, parents donating food, preparing food, set-up and clean-up, and serving the team. The team is fed during camp, 2-a-days, and for all home games during the season and play-offs.

Freshman Yard Signs-- Responsibilities include: Taking orders at Kick-off, cutting out footballs, painting and personalizing each sign, and distributing to players.

Game Day Filming-- Filming each game for coaches review.

Game Day Photography-- Take pictures during each Varsity, JV, and Freshman game. Upload the photographs to www.castlefootball.com.

Golf Scramble-- Coordinate the entire event from beginning to end. Work with Boonville CC to pick a date and menu. Recruit volunteers to work with event. Contact local business for sponsorship of holes. Coordinate half pot and raffle. Put together teams for play.

Gridiron Club-- Gaining exposure and support for CASTLE FOOTBALL. Developing a club to show spirit and support the financial needs of the program.

Highway Signs-- Responsibilities include: Strategically placing highway signs in front of Buehlers and Castle Elementary. Updating home or away sign and changing the name of our opponent each week. Once the season concludes, the signs will need to be placed in storage.

Kickoff Picnic-- The Picnic kicks off the new season. It is held at the beginning of August. Volunteers are needed to secure the cafeteria, set-up, clean-up, handle food, and recruiting grillers.

Locker Signs-- Design a sign to be placed on each player's locker.

Media Guide-- Responsibilities include: Developing a media guide for print. Update 2010 guide with new player information, add more past player statistics, and increase sponsorship with advertisers.

Physical Night-- On May 11, 2011 CFPC will offer an opportunity for all student athletes to have a physical done at the high school. The cost is \$25.00 per student. Volunteers are needed for set-up, clean-up, and to work stations during the event.

Picture Buttons-- Responsibilities include: During Media Day (held sometime in August), snap photographs of each player. Make buttons out of pictures to sell to parents. Responsible for taking orders at the Kickoff Picnic.

Practice Field Improvements-- Completely renovate the practice fields, including laser grading, planting seed, updating sprinkler system, and building a shelter for the trainer to work from and doubling as a location to film.

Public Relations-- Responsibilities include: Contacting local business and media outlets to gain exposure for fundraisers and current events.

Reserved Parking-- Responsibilities include: Accepting reservations at the Kick-off. Assigning parking spots for each reservation and distributing parking passes. Managing the lot before each home game.

Restaurant Donations for Feeds-- Contact local restaurants to secure donations of food and paper products such as napkins and cups.

Senior Yard Signs-- Responsibilities include: Taking orders at Kick-off, cutting out helmet sign, painting and personalizing it and delivering to players. Helmet template is available.

Spirit Wear-- Responsibilities include: Developing a design for the current season. Determining how many styles and colors of shirts to order and whether other products will be sold. Placing all orders for merchandise, selling merchandise, and collecting funds.

Stadium Flags-- Responsibilities include: Before each game, place gold flags on the top of the home side bleachers. Remove the flags once the game is over and place them in storage.

Tailgating-- Coordinating activities for tailgating before each home game.
